I will have supplies available to quickly make a luminary and to write a letter to your baby. If you would prefer to bring a pre-written letter to our October meeting, that is okay too. Your letters can be as long or as brief as you wish. It could simply read "I really miss you." Writing a letter is optional, but I really hope you will all consider joining in this exercise.

I would like to invite everyone to our October meeting! In celebration of Pregnancy & Infant Loss Month, I wanted to do something a little special for this month's gathering. Instead of meeting at Good Shepherd, we will be meeting at Charmel's house for a backyard bonfire. Our meeting date and time will remain the same (Wed. Oct. 4th from 7-9pm), just a different location.

I think this gathering will be really special and I hope you all will consider joining us. Please reach out to Charmel to get my address and so I have an appropriate amount of supplies for everyone who plans to attend. I have some outdoor seating, but chairs are limited. You may want to bring a folding chair or anything else that you may need for the evening. If you did not give last month's luminaries and letters to Charmel, please bring them with you to the October meeting as well. See the above section "September in Review" for more details.

Our Walk to Remember will take place on Sunday, October 8th at 2pm at Unity Village. In the newsletter email, you should have


Other relevant events happening around the metro this month:
