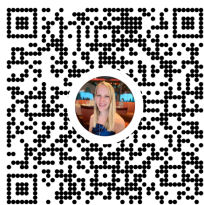

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When your child dies, the idea of a new year can be hard. The idea of 2026 being your "best year ever" or "a fresh start" or "the happiest yet" can seem like the furthest from your reality. New Years celebrations can feel like your baby is being left behind in the past, as you enter a new year which they never existed in. Or perhaps your loss was long ago and the New Year is another reminder of just how much time has passed since you were last physically together. It can feel extra heavy as the world around us celebrates the passage of time and focuses on the happy, shiny, hopeful new year.

This month, I challenge you to change the narrative! Remember:

- ❄️ This day (and tomorrow) are just like every other day without them. Nothing changes!
- ❄️ We always think of them, honor them, carry them with us... we never leave them behind.
- ❄️ Remind yourself they still exist... even in our 2026... not the way we want, but they are here.
- ❄️ Time is a man-made thing. Our kids exist beyond it.

So, set an intention for this upcoming year. What do you want or need it to be? Some good suggestions... more self-care, self-compassion, grace, peace... less stress. Take a small step toward creating a life you can show up in and live. People like to choose a word for their year... what will your 2026 word be?!
